Top technical, business visionaries for Em Tech conference

Nearly a 100 of the world's leading technical and business visionaries will discuss market ready 'incubated technologies' at the Em Tech conference here to be held for the first time outside the US, in March.

The two-day session, to begin on March 2, will see discussions on greener and affordable fuel alternatives, inexpensive life saving drugs and software predicting all things, from traffic patterns to profit making opportunities in the stock market.

The occasion will run parallel to the launch MIT's publication 'Technology Review' in India. "Asian nations became giants by exporting IT services, drug design and embedded systems to the world. By bringing Em Tech 2009 to the Indian shores, we hope to bring into sharper focus emerging technology innovations from Asia and Australia," Jason Pontin, Editor-in-Chief and publisher of Technology Review, said.

Participants from companies in Australia, China, Japan, Malaysia, South East Asia, Singapore, Taiwan, the UK and the US would participate in the conference, the release said.
